

Subject Overview HISTORY – Year 11

Students will cover the final topic of their GCSE course through two lessons per week. The third lesson is dedicated to retrieval of topics studied in year 10. They continue to develop their understanding of key historical skills and concepts from Key Stage 3 while learning about how key events of the past impact modern Britain and its landscape.
